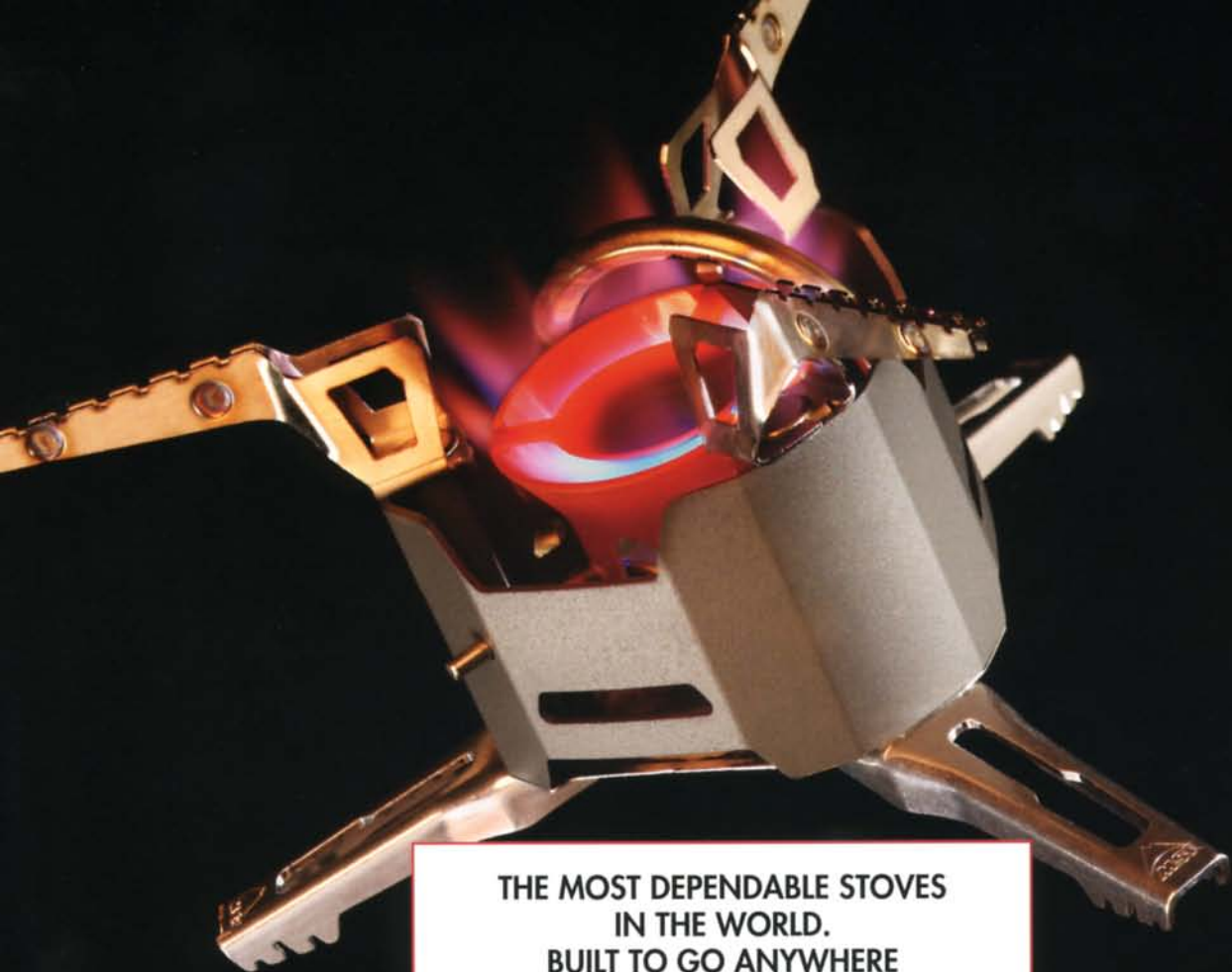

LIQUID-FUEL STOVE ADVANTAGES

In extreme conditions, MSR liquid-fuel stoves are unbeatable. They offer superior bad-weather performance, multi-fuel capability—making them perfect for overseas use—and weight- and space-savings on longer trips. They also burn well no matter how much fuel is in the tank, with levels that can be easily monitored, feature shaker jets for quick cleaning, and include wide pot supports and legs for stability.



SUPERFUEL™

MSR® SuperFuel is the highest-performance white gas on the market, more refined and cleaner-burning than any comparable fuel, and unmatched for reducing clogs and maintenance.

HOW MUCH FUEL SHOULD I BRING?

MSR recommends 3 ounces (89 ml) of liquid fuel per person per day for cooking or 6 ounces (177 ml) for melting snow and cooking. Extremely cold trips may require as much as 15 ounces (444 ml) of liquid fuel per person per day.



SIMMERLITE™

The lightest liquid-fuel stove available, the SimmerLite weighs a mere 8.5 ounces (240 g) and is compact enough to fit in a one-liter pot. It cranks out serious heat, yet can still handle simmering duties.
